What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or ser-

vice you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- Account Balances and Payment History
- Credit History and Credit Score

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How? All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons GRANT COUNTY BANK chooses to share; and whether or not you can limit this sharing.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <i>Grant County Bank has no affiliates.</i>
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. Nonaffiliates we share with can include banks, trust companies, in- surance companies, brokerage firms and investment dealers.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products and services to you. <i>Our joint marketing partners include KASASA, Elan and Cetera</i> <i>Investment Services LLC.</i>
